Readings: Isaiah 6:1–8; Romans 8:12–17; John 3:1–17.

Theme: *Holy, holy, holy* – Isaiah 6:3, “And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is Jehovah of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.”

Talk/Reflect:

1. Why did Isaiah not consider himself holy (Isaiah 6:5)?
2. Have you ever dwelt in the midst of a people with unclean lips?
If so, when and where? How did this affect you?
3. How does one become “a saint” (Isaiah 6:6-7)?
4. What does it mean to be “born again” (John 3:3, 26)?
How does this happen today? Are you born again?
5. Where does the Holy Spirit dwell today (1 Corinthians 3:16)?
What does that make you?
6. How and who is the Lord sending today (Isaiah 6:8)?
7. What role does the Holy Spirit have today (Romans 8:12-17)?



Pray:

- *For the Holy Spirit to fill us with rivers of living water, to connect more closely with the Body of Christ, and to renew our hope and calling in this world and beyond.*

Bless each other by reading Psalm 29. A Psalm of David.
