**Share:**

- *Do you believe in love at first sight?*
- *Have you ever fallen in love? If so, when and how?*



**Readings:** Acts 10:44–48; 1 John 5:1–6; John 15:9–17.

**Theme:** *Falling in love* – Acts 10:44, “While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word.”

**Talk/Reflect:**

- Why was the Holy Spirit “falling” here such a surprise (Acts 10:45)?  
Why would it be a surprise to us?
- How does the gift of the Holy Spirit come (Acts 10:44; Romans 10:17)?  
When and how did it come to you?
- What does it mean that the Holy Spirit “fell” and was “poured out” (Acts 10:44-45)?
- How is what happened in Acts 10 different or the same as what happened in Acts 2?
- How does the Holy Spirit manifest Himself (1 John 1:2, 4:8-9; Acts 10:46)?
- What is your understanding or experience of speaking in tongues (Acts 10:46)?
- How is what happened in Acts 10 relevant for today? How was this life changing for the church and the world (Acts 11:18)?



**Pray:**

- *To be surprised by God.*
- *For more of the Holy Spirit to be poured out upon us.*
- *For more of the work of the Holy Spirit to be manifest through us.*

**Bless each other by reading Psalm 98.**

Oh sing to the LORD a new song,  
for he has done marvelous things!
