Deep purple. Very elemental blackberry/raspberry/menthol aromas and sweet malt/savoury oak. A strikingly rich concentrated wine with deep-set musky blackberry dark chocolate fruit flavours, underlying savoury oak and ripe smooth tannins. Finishes long and sweet. An immaculately balanced wine. **\$529 a bottle.**
