III. USE YOUR WEAPONS AGAINST THE ENEMY.

2 Corinthians 10:4, “For the **weapons of our warfare** are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds.”

A. The word of God.

Matthew 4:4, 7, 10, “But he answered, “It is written...” cf. Note: The enemy knows Scripture too. He can quote it to you. Matthew 4:6.

Luther, “learned how to answer the devil’s theological arguments.”

B. Submission to God and worship.

James 4:7, “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” cf. Psalm 23:5; Romans 12:1; Rev. 12:11.

C. Prayer (cf. enemy’s strategy: “divide and conquer”).

Matthew 16:18, “And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my **church**, and **the gates of hell** shall not prevail against it.”

Ephesians 6:18, “**praying** at all times in the Spirit, with **all prayer** and supplication.”

D. The fruit of the Spirit.
